CIVIL AVIATION

Order no. 6822, of 18 March 2015, established the rules for filing international airline services operational programs.

The regular international airline services operational programs must be filed with the civil aviation authority, for approval, no later than one month prior to their intended date of implementation.

POSTAL NETWORKS AND SERVICES

Decree no. 2015-245, of 4 February 2015, sets forth the administrative and technical requirements for the installation and operation of postal networks and services.

The installation and operation of postal networks and services are subject, as the case may be, to a concession by the Council of Ministers' decree and to an authorization by an act of the regulatory agency.

Decree no. 2015-248, of 4 February 2015, regulates in-country money transfer services by money transmitters (money remittance offices).

Money transmitters only provide in-country money transfer services between natural persons. For transactions abroad, money transmitters must use the services of a Congo-based credit institution, under an agreement signed for this purpose.

The exercise of their activity by money transmitters is subject to obtaining approval from the Minister of Finance.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

Decree no. 2015-255, of 19 February 2015, sets forth the rules for the establishment and operation of electronic communications networks and services and also for the distribution of electronic communications equipment.

The installation and operation of electronic communications networks are subject, depending on the case, to the licensing, authorization, permit, testing and reporting regimes.

The terms and conditions for the reporting and testing regimes are defined by decision of the regulatory agency.

All electronic communications equipment must be placed on the Congolese market by a distributor authorized by the postal and electronic communications regulatory agency, subject to prior issuance of an approval certificate by the latter.
